High Gear Hot Rods ([www.highgearhotrods.com](http://www.highgearhotrods.com)) has a new ride in progress in its Arkansas-based shop, with the goal of combining a '60s vibe in a pickup truck with new technology. Dubbed Retroactive, the '68 Chevy truck will get its old steel replaced with panels from Goodmark Industries, then the body will be bathed in a subtle '60s green from DuPont Hot Hues. The modern LS2 powerplant will receive a retro look via a cast-iron finish, Kinsler fuel injection, and vintage valve covers, but with a F.A.S.T. XFI system controlling things. Old truck suspension just won't do when you've got higher performance goals in mind, so an Air Ride Technologies Big Red system will be dialed in for more aggressive driving and to allow the Chevy to hug the ground and swallow the huge Sugar City wheels from Colorado Custom wrapped in BFGoodrich KDW/TA—2 tires.
